- Grains will be judged as to breeding, conditions of the seed, quality, adaptability to local soil and climatic conditions, purity, uniformity, standard weight and freedom from infestation or disease.
- 4. Samples of grain may be fitted in any manner which will result in an improvement of the value for speed purposes.
- 5. All entries must be confined to printed list.
- 6. Only one entry of each variety by one person.
- 7. Each variety must be grown, named and labeled by the exhibitor.
- 8. In the case of perishable fruit, if the exhibit becomes deteriorated or unsightly, the exhibitor shall, at the request of the Superintendent, replace the item with one of equal value.




